



Terms and Conditions—Residential Indoor Lighting Program

Program Offer: The Program covers products purchased and/or services rendered on or after January 1, 2012.

Program Requirements:

- Compact Fluorescent and LED lamp and fixtures must be ENERGY STAR qualified residential lighting products and listed on the ENERGY STAR list provided on their website at www.energystar.gov.
- The following size and rebate limits will be enforced:
 - Minimum 4 Watts per lamp or fixture.
 - Minimum \$1 purchase price per lamp or fixture and minimum \$5 rebate request.
 - Maximum of \$40 per unit (lamp or fixture) and \$600 per home**
- The following proof of purchase must be provided to the utility:
 - Retail Purchase - Customer must provide receipt and product cutouts for each lamp or fixture. The invoice and product cutouts must confirm product type, quantity, brand, model number and purchase date. For ENERGY STAR Qualified Lamps and Fixtures, the ENERGY STAR logo, product type and model should be visible on a single product cutout.
 - Contractor Installed - Customer must provide contractor invoice. The invoice must include product type, quantity, brand, model number and installation date.
 - For retrofits, proof of purchase must be included for the necessary number of ballasts and lamps as indicated by the quantity and fixture type provided on the rebate form.
- All lighting products must be installed and are subject to utility verification.
- ENERGY STAR Qualified CFL and LED Fixtures apply to many different fixture types, including CFL can fixtures, surface mount, linear fluorescents (typically small single lamp products) and torchiere lamps. All types may qualify for incentives if they meet the minimum wattage requirement of this program.
- Linear fluorescent fixtures must be type T8 or T5 with electronic ballasts.
- A fluorescent fixture retrofit must include the purchase of one or more ballasts and the number of fluorescent lamps indicated by the Type Code provided on the incentive request form.
- ENERGY STAR Verification** can be verified by one of the following:
 - Cutout of package provided to utility displays the ENERGY STAR logo.
 - Utility can use model from contractor invoice, to verify ENERGY STAR qualification.
 - Customer provides printout from ENERGY STAR website (<http://www.energystar.gov>) showing that the product model indicated on their invoice is currently listed as ENERGY STAR qualified.

Warranty Information:

The cooperative makes no warranties, expressed or implied, with respect to equipment operation, material, workmanship or manufacturing. The Cooperative does not guarantee that a certain level of energy or cost savings will result from the use of products covered by this program.

Limitation of Liability:

Participating Members agree that the Cooperative’s liability, in connection with this Program, is limited to paying the Program Incentive specified (when all Terms and Conditions have been satisfied by the member). Under no circumstances shall the Cooperative be liable for any consequential or incidental damages resulting from participation in this Program. The Cooperative will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the Participating Member as a result of the payment of Program Incentives.

Participating Member’s Certification:

Participating Member certifies that he/she purchased and installed the equipment listed in their application at their defined location served by the Cooperative. Participating Member agrees that all information is true and that he/she has conformed to all of the program and equipment requirements listed in the application.

Program Changes/Termination:

While this rebate program will be in effect for an indefinite period, the Cooperative reserves the right to extend, modify (this includes incentive levels) or terminate this Program without prior or further notice. The member is responsible for checking with the Cooperative to determine whether the program has been changed or is still in effect.

Other Conditions:

The Cooperative reserves the right to inspect installations before issuing the rebate. If the application does not comply with the Cooperative’s rules and qualifications, the rebate amount may be adjusted.

Members must apply for rebates within 6 months of the purchase date (as shown on the member’s invoice). Past eligibility, however, does not guarantee that equipment will meet criteria for current programs in effect.
