- Customer provides cutout of bar code symbol and model number from product package.

Fluorescent T-8 or T-5 Fixtures do not have to be Energy Star but must be new fixtures with electronic ballasts using T8 lamps.

Limits are applied to each type of lamp/fixture –See Rebate Table.

Terms and Conditions—Residential Indoor Lighting Program

Program Offer: The Program covers products purchased and/or services rendered **on or after January 1, 2007.**

Program Requirements:

1. CFL lamp and fixtures must be Energy Star (ES) labeled.
2. Fluorescent tube lamp fixtures must be type T8 (or T5) with electronic ballasts.
3. Copy of receipt must be provided to the cooperative.
4. The lighting load must be served the cooperative providing the incentive.
5. Residential rebates are available for a limited number of each type of lighting product (see rebate table on current incentive form)
6. Ag lighting applications must be rated for the intended purpose (See below)

Energy Star Verification:

Energy Star qualification for Residential customers can be verified by one of the following:

1. Customer provides cutout of package showing Energy Star logo, product type and model.
2. Customer provides cutout of UPC code and model from product package.

Agricultural Requirements

1. Special cold-start ballasts are needed for fluorescent lights used in buildings such as machine sheds, free-stall dairy barns and swine growing/finishing buildings.
2. Heat Lamp Sockets - Use porcelain sockets for all lamps designed to produce heat. Fixtures made of rubber and plastic are not acceptable.
3. For livestock buildings:
 - use dust and moisture tight nonmetallic fixtures with shatterproof, vapor tight globes.
 - Select fluorescent light fixtures made of corrosion-resistant materials with gasketed covers.
 - Fixtures with fiberglass or aluminum enclosures and Lexan® covers are recommended. Do not use fixtures made of ABS plastic and with acrylic diffusers in buildings where chemicals and high pressure hot water cleaning and sanitizing systems are used.

Warranty Information:

Your cooperative makes no warranties, expressed or implied, with respect to equipment operation, material, workmanship or manufacturing. The Cooperative does not guarantee that a certain level of energy or cost savings will result from the use of products covered by this program.

Limitation of Liability:

Participating Customers agree that the Cooperative's liability, in connection with this Program, is limited to paying the Program Incentive specified (when all Terms and Conditions have been satisfied by the customer). Under no circumstances shall the Cooperative be liable for any consequential or incidental damages resulting from participation in this Program. The Cooperative will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the Participating Customer as a result of the payment of Program Incentives.

Participating Customer's Certification:

Participating Customer certifies that he/she purchased and installed the equipment listed in their application at their defined location served by the Cooperative. Participating Customer agrees that all information is true and that he/she has conformed to all of the program and equipment requirements listed in the application.

Program Changes/Termination:

While this rebate program will be in effect for an indefinite period, the Cooperative reserve the right to extend, modify (this includes incentive levels) or terminate this Program without prior or further notice. Typically a 60 day will be made in the event that any program is terminated.

Other Program Rules

The cooperative reserves the right to inspect installations before issuing the rebate. If the application does not comply with the cooperative's rules and qualifications, the rebate amount may be adjusted.

Customers must apply for rebates within one year of the purchase date (as shown on the customer's invoice).
