Terms and Conditions—Livestock Ventilation Fan Incentives

This program is only available for agricultural accounts.

Program Offer: The Program covers products purchased and/or services rendered on or after **July 1, 2008**.

- Agricultural ventilation fans must be listed in the current “Agricultural Ventilation fans, performance and Efficiencies” publication developed by (Bio Environmental and Structural Systems Laboratory (BESS Labs) at the University of Illinois
- CFM and efficiency (CFM/watt) values provided for fans below must be **rated at a static pressure of 0.10 inches** as published by BESS Labs.

Required Fan Efficiency (CFM/Watt must be equal to or higher):

- 14”-23” Minimum 10.5 CFM/Watt @ 0.1 in. static pressure
- 24”-35” Minimum 13 CFM/Watt @ 0.1 in. static pressure
- 36”-47” Minimum 16.5 CFM/Watt @ 0.1 in. static pressure
- 48”-49” Minimum 18.5 CFM/Watt @ 0.1 in. static pressure
- 50” & up Minimum 19.5 CFM/Watt @0.1 in. static pressure

Application and Eligibility Process

The Cooperative reserves the right to verify sales transactions and to have reasonable access to the customer’s facility to inspect pre-existing equipment (if applicable) and the Energy-Efficient Measures installed under this Program, either prior to issuing incentives or at a later time.

An invoice is required and must include specific customer information, including, but not limited to the type, size, make and model, serial number and date of purchase of Energy-Efficient Measures. An authorized representative of the Participating Customer must sign, date, and submit the application with the invoice and the manufacturer’s equipment performance sheets. The Customer must ultimately own the equipment, through an up-front purchase or at the end of a short-term lease.

Warranty Information:

Your cooperative makes no warranties, expressed or implied, with respect to equipment operation, material, workmanship or manufacturing. The Cooperative does not guarantee that a certain level of energy or cost savings will result from the use of products covered by this program.

Limitation of Liability:

Participating Member agrees that the Cooperative’s liability, in connection with this Program, is limited to paying the Program Incentive specified (when all Terms and Conditions have been satisfied by the member). Under no circumstances shall the Cooperative be liable for any consequential or incidental damages resulting from participation in this Program. The Cooperative will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the Participating Member as a result of the payment of Program Incentives.

Participating Member’s Certification

Participating Member certifies that he/she purchased and installed the equipment listed in their application at their defined location served by the Cooperative. Participating Member agrees that all information is true and that he/she has conformed to all of the program and equipment requirements listed in the application.

Program Changes/Termination

While this rebate program will be in effect for an indefinite period, the Cooperative reserves the right to extend, modify (including incentive levels) or terminate this Program without prior or further notice.

Other Program Rules

The cooperative reserves the right to inspect installations before issuing the rebate. If the application does not comply with the cooperative’s current rules and qualifications, the rebate amount may be adjusted.
