

2023 Detour Map – Access to T.I.P. REC Offices

The City of Brooklyn and Poweshiek County have begun major reconstruction projects within the Brooklyn city limits that will negatively impact normal access routes to the T.I.P. office.

- 1) Beginning early April 2023 – The bridge over Big Bear Creek on V18/Jackson St. on the north end of town will be closed for reconstruction. This road closing will eliminate access to town from the north (Hwy. 6). This closure is expected to last into the fall of 2023.
- 2) Beginning late April 2023 – The City of Brooklyn will begin a full depth reconstruction (water/sewer/pavement) on Jackson St. stretching from 2nd St on the south end (corner of Casey's) to the BGM HS parking lot on the north end. This will result in Jackson St. being closed to all thru traffic until the fall of 2023.

Visitors to the T.I.P. office are encouraged to enter Brooklyn from the south on V18, or east/west on Old Highway 6. From there:

- 1) Proceed west from the corner of Jackson/2nd (Casey's corner) up the hill for 2 blocks
- 2) Turn North onto Orchard St. for 1 block
- 3) Turn West onto West Pershing Drive for 1 block
- 4) Turn North onto West St. for 1 block
- 5) Proceed into our parking lot across the intersection of West St./West Des Moines St.
